

# WOUND PATHOGEN PANEL

**Collection Instructions** 

- 1 Sterile swab
- 1 Sterile virus transport media (collection tube)
- 1 Biohazard bag
  - 2 Barcode labels
  - 1 Parafilm sealing sheet
  - 1 Absorbent sheet

- Return supplies:
  - UN3373 Biological substance, Category "B" stamped FedEx Clinical pak
  - Corrugated return box
  - FedEx Return label

## **Collection Procedures**

### SPECIMEN COLLECTION

- 1. Remove sterile swab from collection kit being careful not to contaminate the tip.
- 2. Follow one of the sample collection methods below based upon the type of wound:
  - Decubitus Ulcer
    - a. Roll the sterile swab directly across the affected area until saturated
    - b. Proceed to step 3
  - Abscess with Skin Intact
    - a. Use sterile needle/syringe to aspirate approximately 1ml of purulent material
    - b. Eject aspirated material into sterile collection cup
    - c. Roll sterile swab in collection cup to saturate swab
    - d. Proceed to step 3
  - Abscess with Open Skin/Sinus Tract
    - a. Wipe skin around opening with 70% ethanol or equivalent
    - b. Roll sterile swab with purulent material within abscess/sinus and ensure it is saturated
    - c. Proceed to step 3
- 3. Place swab in collection tube, swirl the swab in the solution 5 times, break at indentation mark and recap (with the swab in the tube).
- 4. Keep the collection tube in the upright position for 10-15 minutes before sending for testing.

## Safety Information:

- Always wear appropriate protective equipment when handling any clinical specimen. These include lab coats, disposable gloves, and a face mask.
- Do not touch your face when handling specimens. Periodically change gloves and disinfect surfaces with 10% bleach and 70% ethanol.
- Always wash hands thoroughly with soap after handing specimens.

#### . . Materials

Required
